Lots of disabled people need to use more electricity and gas.

This can be very expensive and can mean that you can go into **debt**.

Debt is when you owe someone money.



Sometimes the company that supplies the gas or electricity will say you have to have a pre payment meter.

The pre payment meter means that your gas or electricity will only work if money has been paid before you use it.



This can mean that if you can't afford to buy energy then your electricity or gas stops working.
